## COMMUTER BUS SERVICES TO WASHINGTON, D.C.

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MTA Commuter buses operate Monday thru Friday. There is no service on Saturdays, Sundays, and the following federally-observed holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Friday after Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

Only cash one-way fares using exact change may be purchased on the bus. Ten trip tickets and monthly passes can be purchased online at [MTA.CommuterDirect.com](http://MTA.CommuterDirect.com) or by calling 410-697-2212.

Reduced fares are available for senior citizens (65+), persons with disabilities, and Medicare cardholders. To be eligible, you must show one of the following; a valid MTA Senior/Disability photo ID card, or any valid government issued photo ID with proof of age, or a valid disability ID from another transit agency with any valid government issued photo ID, or a Medicare card with any valid government photo ID.

## REGIONAL TRANSIT CONNECTIONS

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STS's route 5 (Calvert Connection) travels from Lexington Park to Solomons providing a connection to CCPT.

VanGO's Charlotte Hall route connects with STS routes 2, 4, 6, 12 and 14 providing access to Charles County and beyond.

VanGO's Business A and Pinefield routes link to Prince George's County The Bus route 36 at the Pinefield South Shopping Center.

WMATA route W19 travels from Indian Head to the Southern Avenue Metrorail Station (green line). Call 202-637-7000 for schedule and fare information.
